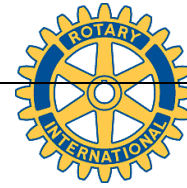

There are 250 million children in Kenya who are alone on the streets. Some projects are New Life Home for boys, TEMAK for girls, and Street Boys of Kisumo.

AGAPE is a place/school/home for children

of the street who are able to enter, and has been a project of the Oakdale club for the past ten years.

With the District’s 55 clubs donations of \$1,000 per club, plus, and matching District and RI Foundation money, they should have \$210,000 for the project.
