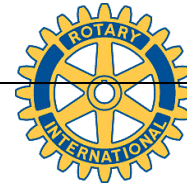

Barbara Hutchison, Dir. Of Admissions, Valley Gardens Health Care and Rehab. Center was our speaker of the day.

She explained about senior care and what is covered by Medicare, insurance and Medi-Cal and private pay. She emphasized that the “3-day stay” in a hospital before going to a convalescent facility is really “three midnights”. That sort of means four days, huh? Medicare will pay 100% for the first 20 days and then supplement insurance, if purchased, takes over a part of the payment for the next 80 days.

There are different types of facilities and you should be certain they are “Medicare Approved”, or the bills won’t be paid.

Barbara said there is a severe shortage of approved facilities that can take Alzheimer’s patients. Thanks, Barbara for a very informative and interesting talk.
